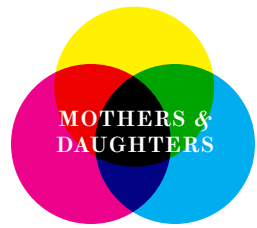

the cleft in her chin that Pat admittedly envies—runway model Anna says that she has drawn on her mother’s strength and beauty while watching her on the runway, though she
